



The most culturally diverse suburbs within Hobsons Bay are Laverton, Brooklyn and Altona North





# Resident feedback on climate change


We're concerned about health impacts on wellbeing, specifically the ability to enjoy outdoor activity and heat impacts on energy use and bills






#### Ways we travel
