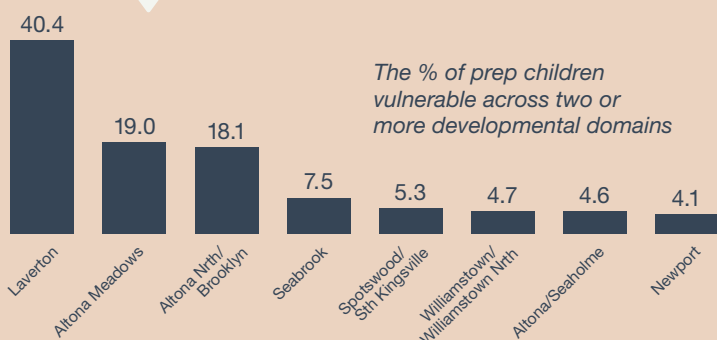

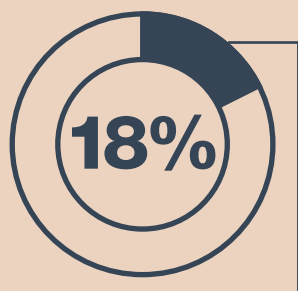
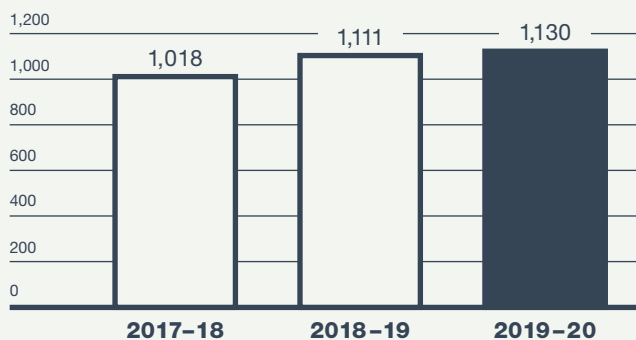
Three-quarters of affected family members involved in family incidents in Hobsons Bay were female

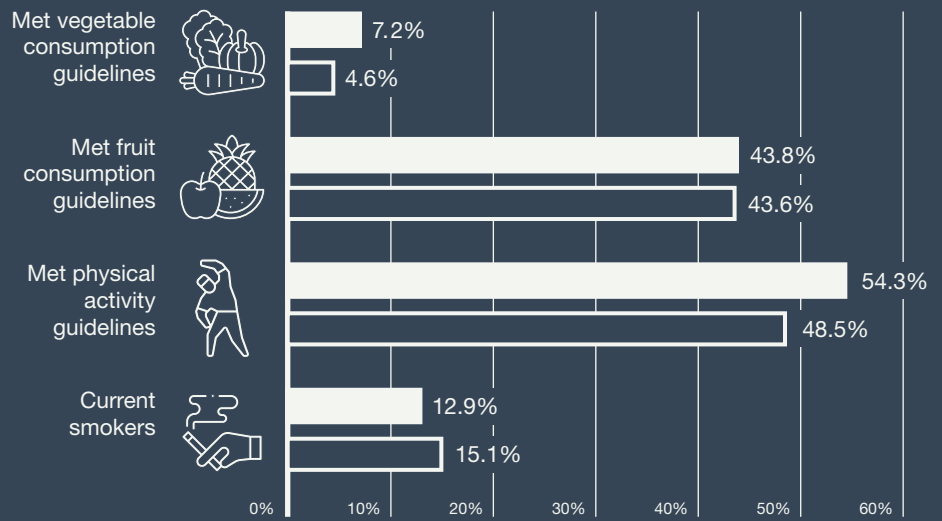

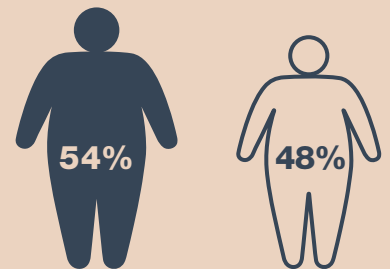

Pokies

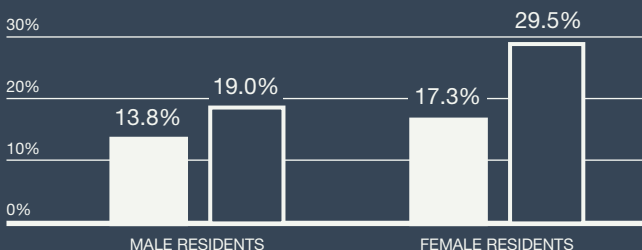

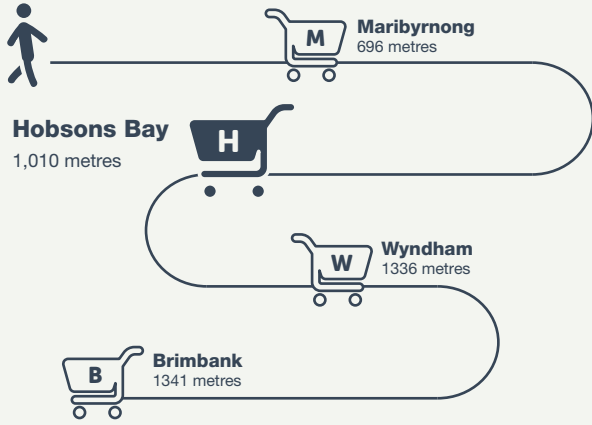

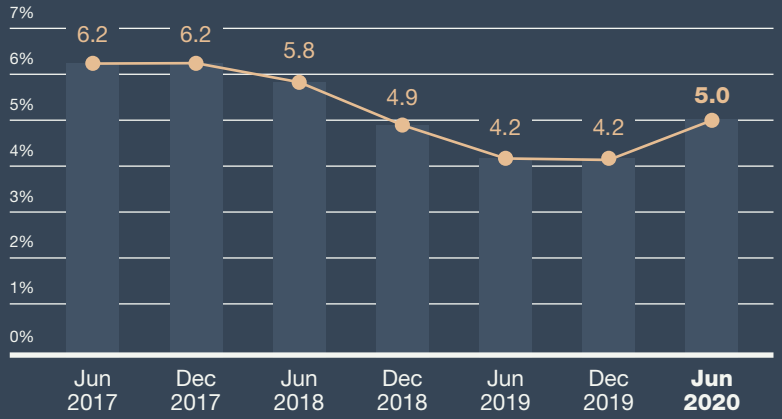

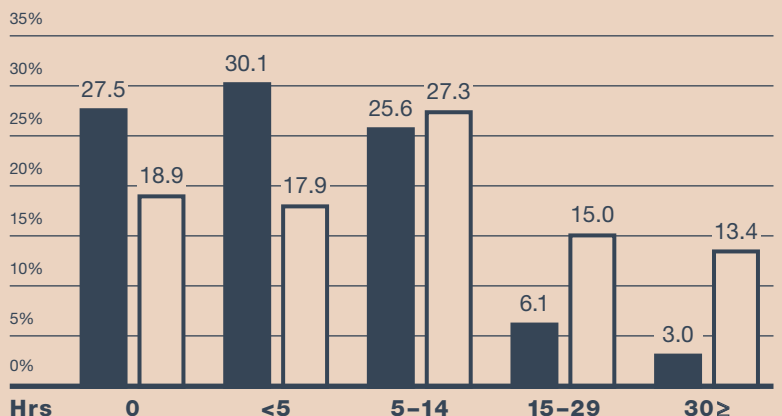

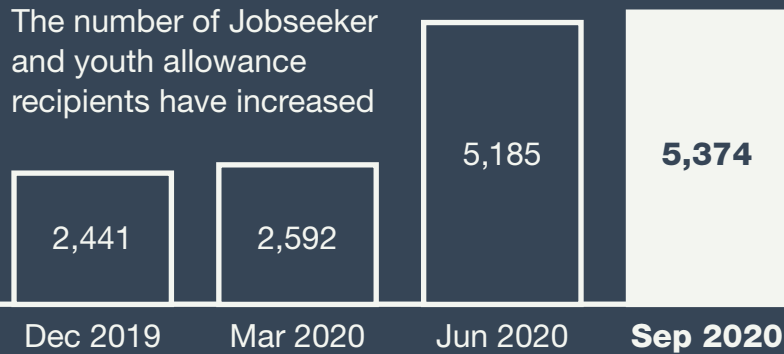
Unpaid domestic work higher among women in Hobsons Bay

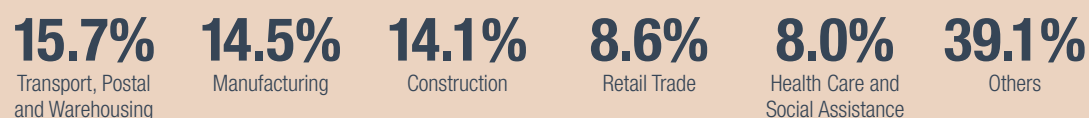
The number of Jobseeker and youth allowance recipients have increased

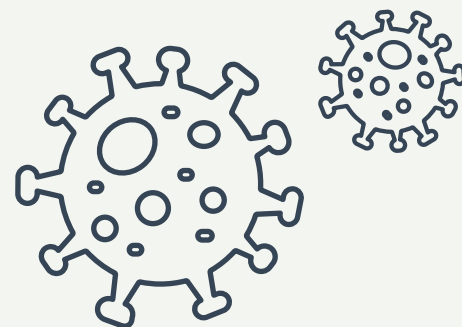
